The Bursary award scheme has seen the disbursement of Kshs. 2,141,284.00 to students in the period it has been in place.

Below is a breakdown of the bursary awards by Ward

- Majengo Ward- 245 students received bursary from the committee worth Kshs. 752,471,(144 are girls and 101 are boys.)
- Tononoka Ward- 192 students received bursaries worth Kshs. 629,113.(103 girls and 89 boys).
- Shimanzi Ward -91 beneficiaries .The amount allocated to them is Kshs. 266,200 .(64 girls and 27 boys).
- King'orani Ward- Kshs. 316,100 104 beneficiaries. (45 girls and 59 boys)
- Bondeni - Kshs. 81,900.40 beneficiaries.(26 of them girls and 14 boys).
- Mwembe Tayari- Kshs. 92,500, 27 beneficiaries . (21 girls and 6 boys.)
